32 PROPOSED CHANGES TO CONTRACT PROCEDURE RULES TO REFLECT PROVIDER SELECTION REGIME LEGISLATION FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC HEALTH PROCUREMENTS

The Head of Legal and Democratic Services submitted a written report outlining the proposed changes to contract procedure rules to reflect provider selection regime legislation for certain public health procurements.

The report sought the Committee's approval for the proposed amendments which was enabled by the new legislation for Public Health Services which came into being on 1 January 2024. The new legislation replaced the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 for applicable Public Health procurements and therefore necessitated amendments to the Contract Procedure Rules.

*RESOLVED that it be recommended to Council that the proposed changes to contract procedure rules to reflect provider selection regime legislation for certain public health procurements be approved.
